Due to Governor Kemp's Statewide Shelter in Place Executive Order signed at 3:12 p.m. on April 2, 2020, the Ogeechee Valley Country Club will remain open for outdoor recreation activity. The Executive Order will be in effect from 6:00 p.m. April 3 through 11:59 p.m. April 13.

During this unprecedented time, all golfers and members who are on the premises at OVCC will be required to adhere to the **President's Coronavirus Guidelines For America (30 Days To Slow The Spread)**. In addition to the Presidential Guidelines, all golfers should use the social distancing procedures and the new on-course procedures to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Below are just a few procedures all members should follow during this Executive Order, along with common sense:

- ① Maintain a minimum distance of 6' between yourself and any of your playing competitors.
- ① Putt with the flagstick in the hole at all times. The golf holes have a Styrofoam cover of hole so the ball will not have to be picked up from the bottom of the hole. If your ball hits the Styrofoam, you may count it.
- ① There will be no rakes in the sand traps to eliminate touching the rakes. You may take a free drop from the sand traps.
- ① There will be no ball washers on the course to eliminate touching the ball washer.
- ① No one is to ride in a golf cart with another person. All golfers are to ride in individual golf carts, or walk. If you do not have a golf cart, the club will provide you a free golf cart to ride in during this time.
- ① Use hand sanitizer before and after any exchanges are made. Hand sanitizer will be provided in the pro shop and on the outside tables.
- ① DO NOT TOUCH YOUR FACE!
- ① Use Common Sense for the health and safety of all those around you!
